New MT Minimum Qualifications

GRADE 1	 No experience required (1 year of experience in the vocation is recommended)
GRADE 2	2 years of experience in the vocation
GRADE 3	 MT Grade 2 certification in good standing 4 years of experience in the vocation OR 3 years with a bachelor's degree or a water/wastewater associate degree
GRADE 4	 MT Grade 3 certification in good standing 6 years of experience in the vocation OR 5 years with a bachelor's degree or a water/wastewater associate degree 1 year experience supervising others in the vocation, crew lead experience qualifies

^{*}Related experience from outside industries will be evaluated and may count for up to 50% of experience for Grade 2 (1 year), and no more than 25% for Grades 3 and 4.

^{*}Mechanical experience at a wastewater or water treatment plant are both considered acceptable forms of experience.
